## **Install Cisco VPN Client**

**NOTE:** If at any point during the installation you are prompted to install or enable 'ActiveX', always select the affirmative option (ie. Yes, Run, Accept, etc.)

1. Navigate to the appropriate URL:

2. If you encounter a certificate error, select 'Continue to this website (not recommended)'.

- 2. An installer page will launch and will show PACS with a progress bar to indicate the application is installing. You may need to click the 'Click here' link to start the process.
