

# How to Print COVID-19 Test Results in Your MySaskHealthRecord

For COVID-19 results, MySaskHealthRecord displays the results based on what is received from the labs. If you got tested for COVID-19 and have a MySaskHealthRecord account, you may see your result in one of two ways.

**Display #1:** You will see the test result of positive or negative under the “Test Result” column on the Laboratory Test Results section

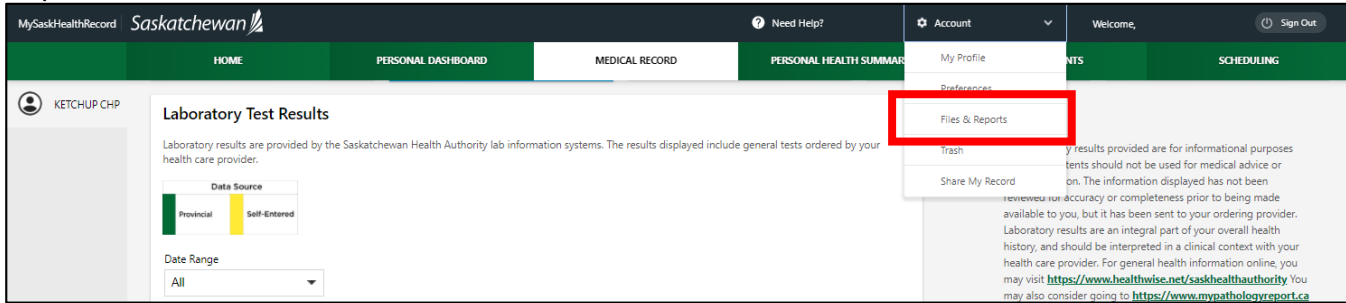

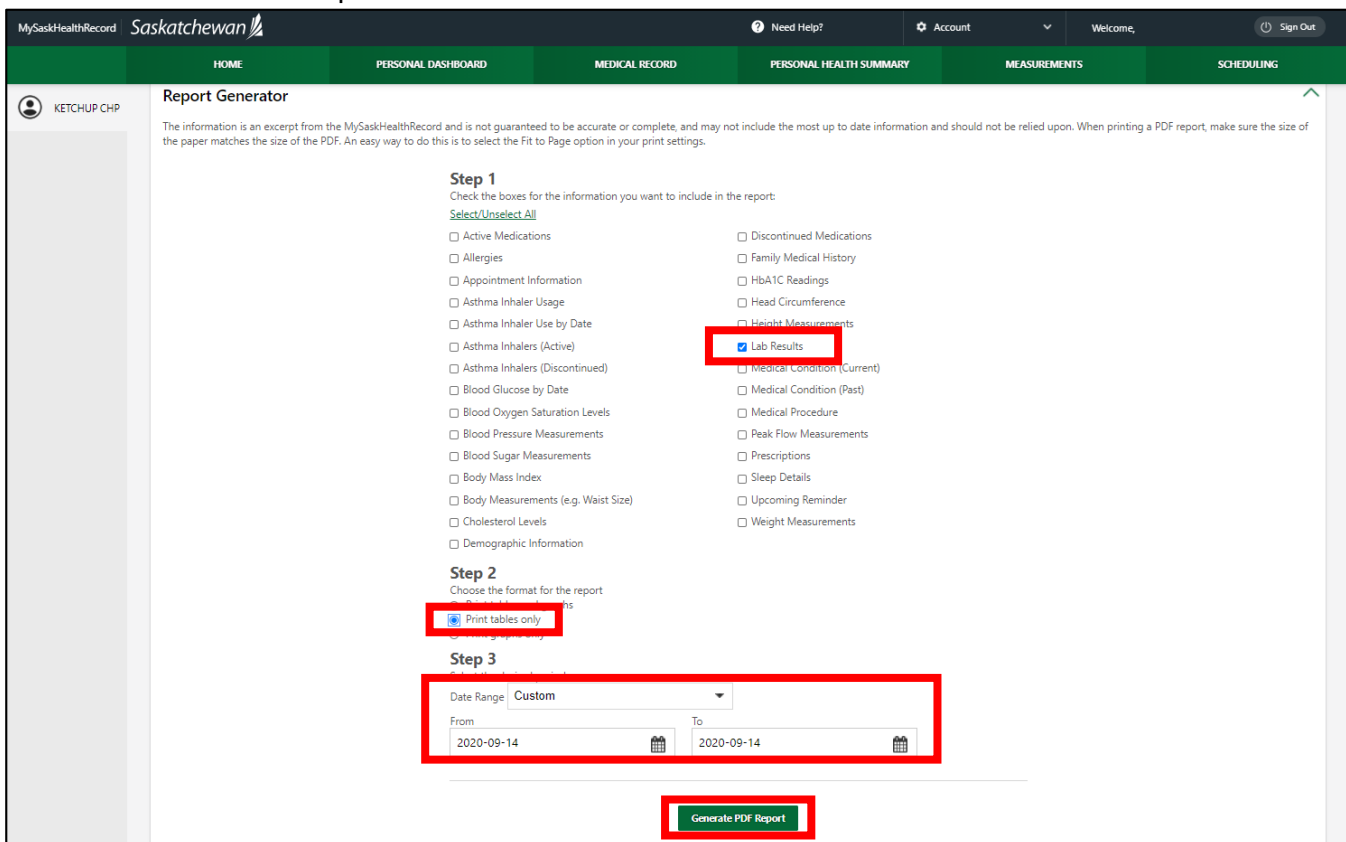
## Print Display #1 – Option 2

- You can print a PDF report using the Report Generator feature in MySaskHealthRecord.

**Step 1:** Log in to your MySaskHealthRecord account and navigate to the Account option, and select “Files and Reports”



**Step 2:** Under Report Generator, select the “Lab Results” check box in Step 1, select “Print tables only” in Step 2, select “Custom” in Step 3 so that the date range includes the date of the COVID-19 test result, then select “Generate PDF Report”



**Step 3:** A PDF report will be generated in the following format and available to print. This will include your full name, date, and the result.
