

Who Can Apply for a Commemorative Stillbirth Certificate

The following is a list of people, according to their **relationship or situation**, who are eligible to apply for and receive a **Commemorative Stillbirth Certificate**:

- The **mother, father** or any **other parent** as listed on the original registration of stillbirth
- An adult **sister or brother** of the stillbirth infant
- A person **authorized in writing** by a parent or sibling of the stillborn child
- The **personal or property guardian** of a parent or sibling of the stillborn child. *A copy of the **Court Order** or other legal documents must be provided with their application*
- In response to a **Saskatchewan court order** or **subpoena**. *A copy of the court document must accompany the application*

Copies of the registration and medical certificate of stillbirth can be issued:

- To the **doctor** or **coroner** that signed the original certificate of stillbirth
- A **coroner** or **medical health official** conducting an investigation or a program to control a disease
- A person applying for a **disinterment** permit as required by any Act or regulation
- **Police services** conducting an investigation
 - municipal, provincial, territorial or RCMP
 - the Department of Citizenship and Immigration
 - the Canadian Security Intelligence Service (CSIS)
 - the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA)
