Population	Doses in Primary Series	Interval to 1 <sup>st</sup> Booster  (mRNA preferred)	Interval to 2 <sup>nd</sup> Booster (mRNA preferred)
18+ living in Long Term care facilities, Personal Care Homes or other congregate living settings that provide care for seniors	2	4 months	4 months
50+ who received Janssen vaccine	1	2 months	4 months
18-49 who received Janssen vaccine	1	2 months	Currently not available
50+ who received viral vector or mixed doses followed by mRNA doses for travel	varies	4 month	4 months regardless of doses previously received
18–49 years old who received viral vector or mixed doses followed by mRNA doses for travel	varies	4 month	Currently not available
50+ healthy or clinically vulnerable individuals	2	4 months	4 months
12-49 years old healthy or clinically vulnerable individuals	2	4 month	Currently not available
50+ moderately to severely immune compromised individuals	3	3 months	4 months
12-49 years old moderately to severely immune compromised individuals	3	3 months	Currently not available
