

Person Demographics

The Person Demographic screen allows you to confirm that this is the patient to whom you are providing health care services. This is an important check to perform prior to viewing sensitive personal health information. Depending on the permission level you have certain icons may not appear.

This is the context bar which identifies the demographic information of the person whose profile you are viewing. This bar stays visible as clinical information is viewed
