## Bulletin #046: Recording TB Skin Tests and PPD

#### **Issue Description**

It has come to the attention of the Panorama Support Team that several TB Skin Tests are being charted incorrectly as PPD Immunization Events.

#### **Issue Resolution**

New TB Skin Tests performed on a Client must be charted from the TB Skin Test Summary screen. If a TB Skin Test was previously charted as a PPD Immunization Event, the TB Skin Test can still be charted as a historical TB Skin Test by completing the steps below.

Note: Please review the Tuberculin Skin Tests policy found on the Panorama Gateway for more information on documenting Tuberculin Skin Tests.

#### **Panorama Steps**

- Note: TB Test Read details must be recorded by a User in the same Organization as the User who recorded the TB Test Given Details. For example, if the TB Test Given details were recorded in Panorama by a User from RQHR, only RQHR Users can record the TB Test Read details.
  - If the TB Test Read was recorded in another Organization other than your own, you will need to contact the appropriate Organization to have the TB Test Results recorded in Panorama.
- 1. Ensure you are logged into Panorama, the Immunizations module has been selected from the top menu, and the appropriate Client is in context.
- 2. From the Left Hand Navigation, select Immunizations > TB Skin Test Summary.

- 3. Click the Create TB Skin Test button to create a new TB Skin Test.
  - a. If this is a historical TB Skin Test, select the **Historical** checkbox from the Test Given Details section. Enter any fields as required and skip to Step 8.
- 4. Complete the Clinical Information section as required.
- 5. Complete the Test Given Details section as required.
- 6. If the TB Skin Test has been read, complete the Test Read Details section and TB Follow Up section as required.
  - a. If the TB Skin Test has yet to be read, skip the Test Read Details and TB Follow Up section in Step 6 below. This TB Skin Test can be updated with Test Read Details and TB Follow Up details once the skin test has been read.
- 7. Click the **Save** button to save the TB Skin Test.
