Panorama Steps

With the Client in Context, Client Details, Immigration screen

1. With the Client in context, select **Client Details > Immigration Information** from the Left Hand Navigation.
2. Enter the reported **Arrival Date** for the Client.
3. Select "**Convention Refugee**" from the **Immigration Status at Time of Arrival** field.
4. Select the country as the **Country Emigrated From**.
5. Select the **Country Born In**.
6. Click the **Save** button.
