Bulletin #065: Consent for TB Skin Tests

Description

A client has come in for a TB Skin Test which requires the nurse to obtain and record consent for the TB Skin Test service.

Panorama Steps

Consent for TB Skin Tests should be recorded through the left hand navigation menu (LHN) under "Consent Directives/All Services" opposed to recording consent for the PPD agent as an immunization service.

- 1) With a client in context navigate to "Client \ Consent Directives \ All Services"
- 2) In the "Consent Directive Summary" section select:
 - Directive Category: Service;
 - Directive Sub Category: TB Skin Tests; and
 - Directive Type Name: Service for TB Test.
- 3) Click the "Create New" button
- 4) Select "Confirmed" for the Directive Status
- 5) Select "Grant" or "Refuse" for the Instruction. If the instruction is set to refuse type in brief reason
- 6) Optionally you can record who consent was given by, along with the form of consent
- 7) Click the Submit button

Note: This consent directive covers the administration of the test and the results/reading 48-72 hour later.
