

Information Bulletin 0017 - Risk Factor Alert and Risk Factor Categories

Issue:

Start Date and End Date for Client Risk Factor - DO NOT USE

There is a known functional defect in Panorama that results in the invalidation of historical vaccine doses if start and end dates are used for risk factors. Until otherwise advised – **DO NOT** enter information into the **Start Date** field or **End Date** field in the Risk Factors screen (see screen shot below).
