## POLICY:

The JOrg (Jurisdictional Organization representing the RHA/FNJ) of the Client will be updated in Panorama when a Panorama user is aware a client resides in a different RHA/FNJ in Saskatchewan.

## PURPOSE:

A Client's JOrg should be updated in Panorama when the user becomes aware that a client has moved to a different health jurisdiction (RHA/FNJ) to ensure that services continue to be provided in a timely manner.

The JOrg is not linked to the Client's <u>Address</u> in Panorama and does not automatically update when a new address is imported from SCI.

## **PROCEDURE:**

When a Panorama user is aware that a client resides in a different health jurisdiction (RHA/FNJ), the user will:

- Go to the Organization: Find button (under <u>Client</u> on the left hand menu <u>Personal</u> <u>Information</u> screen) and click the Find button, and in the Organization Name field start typing name to find the appropriate organization (JOrg) and then click the Select button and press Save.
  - The previous JOrg (RHA/FNJ) will display in the <u>Health Region History</u> section of the Client's record.
  - Ensure the Client's record is set as "Active" on this screen and press Save (if previously set to Inactive status and changed).
