POLICY:

- A. Only publicly funded biological products that are ordered from and supplied by the Saskatchewan Disease Control Laboratory vaccine depot are listed in the inventory module and require a manual physical count. Manual physical counts must be completed on or by the last day of every month in all holding point locations.
- B. Holding points may be requested to perform additional manual physical counts of specific vaccines (e.g., influenza vaccines) for tracking and reporting purposes.
- C. Non-publicly funded biological products will not /cannot be entered into the Inventory module. Examples: Synagis, varicella immune globulin (Varlg) and hepatitis B immune globulin (HBIg).

PURPOSE:

- 1. To ensure quantity on hand (QoH) inventories are accurate to accommodate the autodecrementing functionality in the immunization module.
- 2. To ensure that the vaccine inventory is accurate for tracking and reporting purposes.

Manual inventory physical counts also provide opportunities to reconcile inventory count as variances.

PROCEDURE:

Authorized users will perform a manual inventory physical count including counting antigens by product brand name, reviewing corresponding lot numbers for vaccine packages/boxes, product expiry dates and doses on hand for in-stock products.

Note: Opened multidose vials are to be counted as **9 doses** to ensure adequate product available for auto-decrementing functionality.
