POLICY:

The lot number noted on the external packages of a biological product will be used to reference that product in the inventory and immunization modules. Lot numbers noted on the vial or prefilled syringe of a product may vary from the lot number noted on its external package and will not be referenced or recorded in Panorama.

PURPOSES:

- 1. To standardize immunization-related documentation practices of biological products in the immunization module.
- 2. To standardize the management of biological products in the inventory module.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The lot numbers of publicly funded biological products will be entered into the inventory module by SDCL staff.
- 2. These lot numbers automatically populate the immunization module and a lot number must be selected for the client's immunization record to decrement from the inventory module.
- 3. Lot numbers on publicly funded biological products vials or prefilled syringes are not to be entered into the client's immunization record under any circumstance.
