Panorama: View Inventory

<u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this exercise is to walk through the required steps in Panorama to view inventory items in a Holding Point or across a region.

<u>Scenario</u>

User needs to lookup how much stock they have on hand for a product or number of products.

Use the view inventory function when you need to see the details of the inventory that is stored in a specific Holding Point or organization

<u>Steps</u>

- Log into Panorama
- Open the Inventory Component
- Select Inventory Maintenance from the left hand navigation menu
- Select View Inventory
- View Inventory several ways:
 - o Add a Holding Point
 - o View Inventory
 - Select a Product Alternate ID
 - o View Inventory

Have the following information:

- The catalogue item do you want to view and / or holding point.
- The holding point do you want to view.
