



## **Inventory Maintenance**

### Panorama: Adjust Inventory

#### <u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this exercise is to describe the required steps in Panorama to adjust inventory items in a Holding Point Location

#### Steps are:

- Search existing adjustment
- If the adjustment is found -> review information and update if necessary
- If the adjustment is not found -> create a new one
  - Select the HP
  - o Select the Reconciliation type (Quantity on hand adjustment)
  - Select Catalogue item
  - Enter quantity to adjust
  - o Select the reason for the adjustment
  - Save the adjustment

#### Data required to do an adjust:

- Holding Point where the adjustment is required
- Catalogue item that requires adjustment
- Reason why the quantity is being adjusted
- Enter the quantity on hand
- Save and confirm the adjustment
