

# Important Update: Changes to the TPM Payment Amount, Q1 (Year 2) Payment Date and Notification of Change of Status

Dear TPM Physicians,

This email is to let you know of a few important updates regarding the Transitional Payment Model (TPM) as we head into the coming year (2025–26 fiscal year) of TPM.

## 1. Changes to the TPM Maximum Payable Amount – Effective April 1, 2025:

Effective April 1, 2025, the TPM maximum payable amount has increased to \$146,966.40 (\$36,741.60 quarterly). This increase aligns with the negotiated general fee increase of 2.06% for family practice.

## 2. Payment Details for Q1 (Year 2)

Please take note of the following important dates for payment processing:

- **Claim Submissions:**

All claims must be submitted by **July 21, 2025**, to be included in the **Q1 (Year 2)** calculation.

Claims submitted after July 21, 2025, will be considered as part of the end of the year reconciliation process.

- **Payment Date: August 12, 2025**

This payment date was selected to provide TPM physicians with adequate time to complete and submit their billings.

## 3. Changes to Status – Notification Requirement:

Please notify the TPM Team of any changes to your status. This includes:

- **Extended leave of absence** (e.g., parental, medical)
  - Please inform the TPM team of your absence and anticipated date of return.
  - A leave of absence of six months or longer may require an adjustment to your panel (if applicable).
- **Retirement**
- **Relocation outside the province**
- **Withdrawal from family medicine practice**
- **Change of Practice from FFS to NFFS**
