

How to use SK Vax Wallet

to store and present vaccination QR codes
using your mobile phone or tablet



SK Vax Wallet

Step 1 – Download the SK Vax Wallet Application

Search for SK Vax Wallet in Google Play* or Apple app stores and download to your mobile phone or tablet.

NOTE: This app is not mandatory. Advantages:

- **Convenient:**
 - It works fully offline; compatible with iOS/Apple and Android devices.
 - A personal green/red notice lets you know if you meet the vaccination requirements before you get to an event/business (based on government's vaccination criteria, when scanned by SK Vax Verifier.)
 - The ability to keep your whole family's vaccination certificates in one, easy-to-access place.
- **Secure:** no customer tracking, no information shared/retained
- **Accessible:** e.g. visually impaired; compatible with screen readers

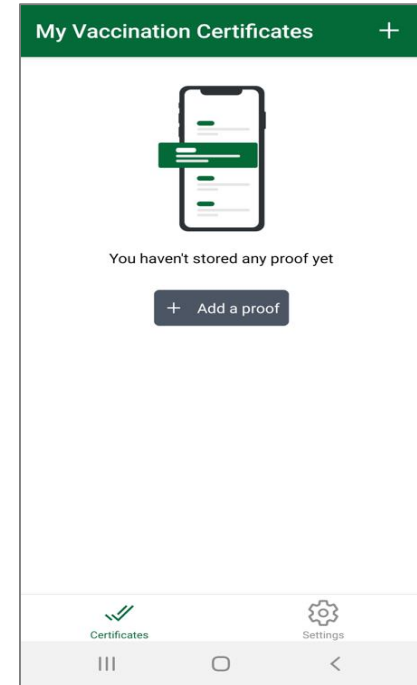
Step 2 – Open the SK Vax Wallet Application



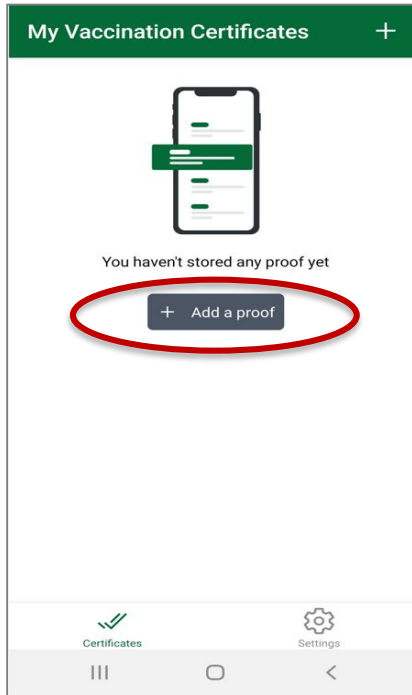
SK Vax Wallet

Tap the SK Vax Wallet icon on your device.

Application opens to the “Certificates” window.

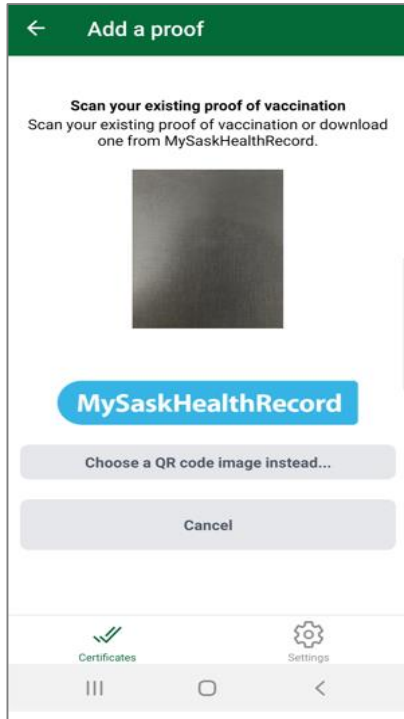


Step 3 – Add proof of vaccination



In the “Certificates” window, tap the “Add a proof” button.

Step 4 – Choose an option to add your proof of vaccination



Choose one of three ways to “Add a proof” of vaccination:

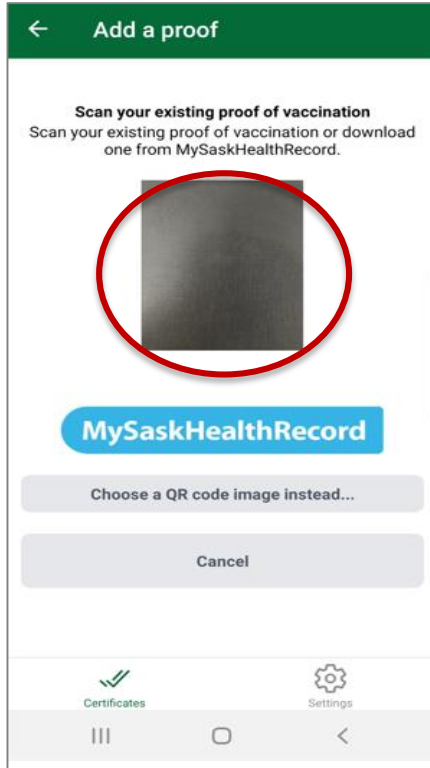
A. Scan your existing proof of vaccination:

Use your camera to scan your QR code from a printout or computer screen

B. MySaskHealthRecord: Download your QR Code from your MySaskHealthRecord.

C. Choose a QR code image instead: Load a stored image of your QR code from wherever you have saved it on your device.

Step 4 – Example A: Add QR code using your camera

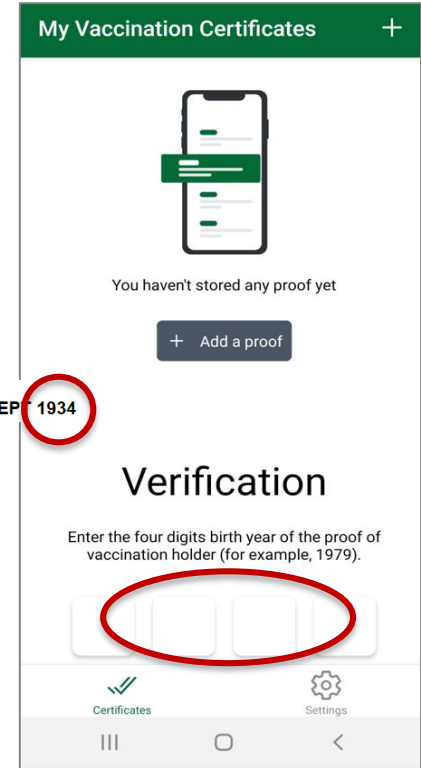


Aim your camera at your QR code until image loads.

You may be asked to enter your 4 digit year of birth. It **must match** the year shown on your vaccination record.

Name / Nom : FAMILYNAME, GIVENNAME
Date of birth / Date de naissance : 19 SEP / SEP 1934

Next, proceed to Step 5.

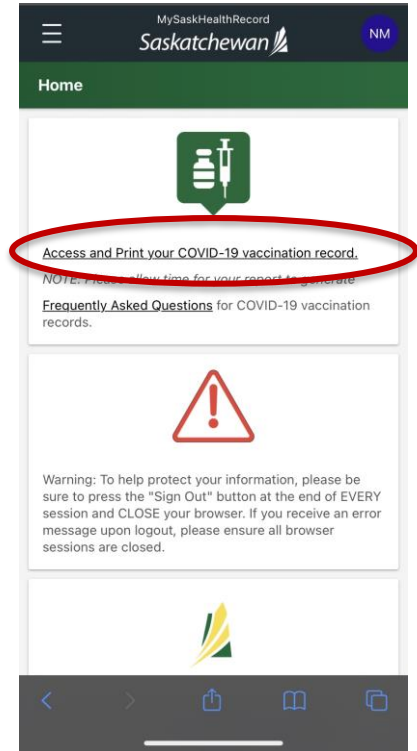


Step 4 – Example B: Add QR code from MySaskHealthRecord

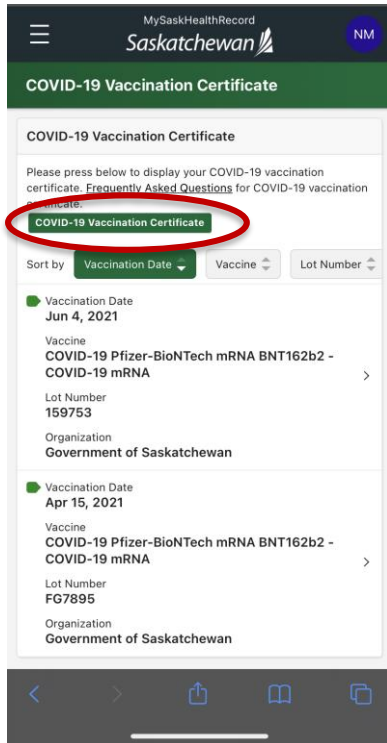


Log in to your MySaskHealthRecord account at ehealthsask.ca.

Tap on “Access and print your COVID-19 vaccination record.”



Step 4 – Example B: Add QR code from MySaskHealthRecord



Tap on the “COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate” button.

Your QR code and vaccines administered will display.

Screen capture on your device or select the green “View” button to see the full certificate

- It can be saved for use when required, or screen captured on your device. Save it somewhere like a photo album, so it's easy to call up and have ready.

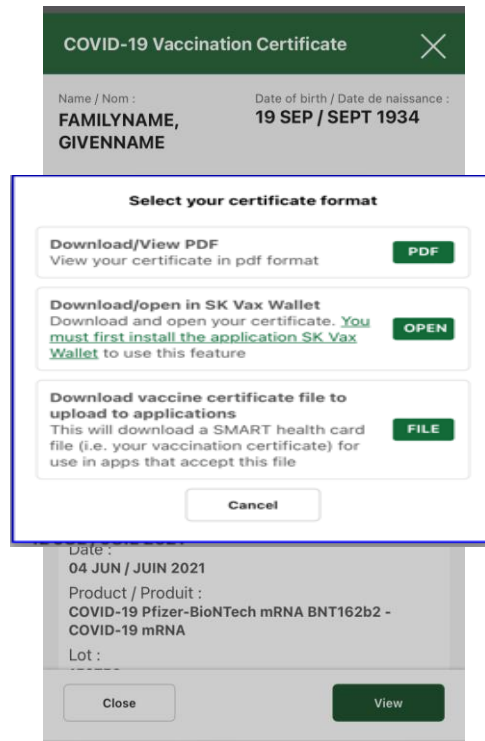
Step 4 – Example B: Add QR Code from MySaskHealthRecord

This is the next screen you will see.

Download/View PDF – Tap this to see your record.

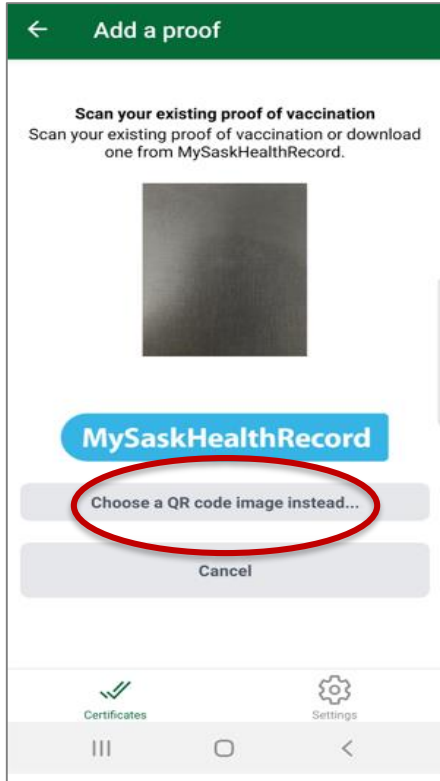
Download/open in SK Vax Wallet – If you already have the SK Vax Wallet installed on your device, this feature will load your Proof of Vaccination to your wallet. *(Not currently available, coming soon.)*

Download vaccine certificate file to upload to applications – This downloads a SMART health card file (i.e. your vaccination record) for use in apps that accept this file.



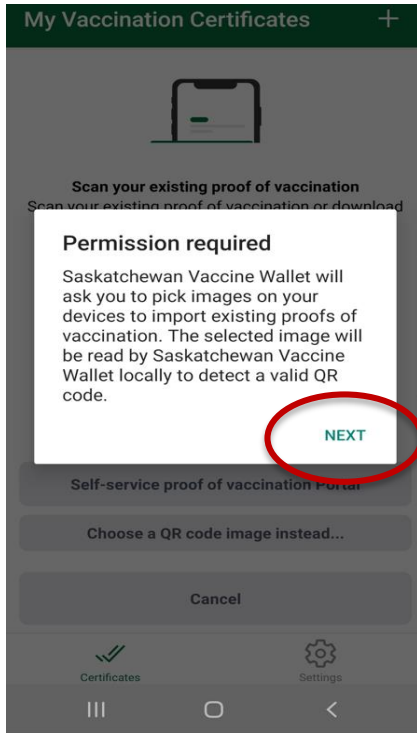

Step 4 – Example C: Add QR code using stored image or file

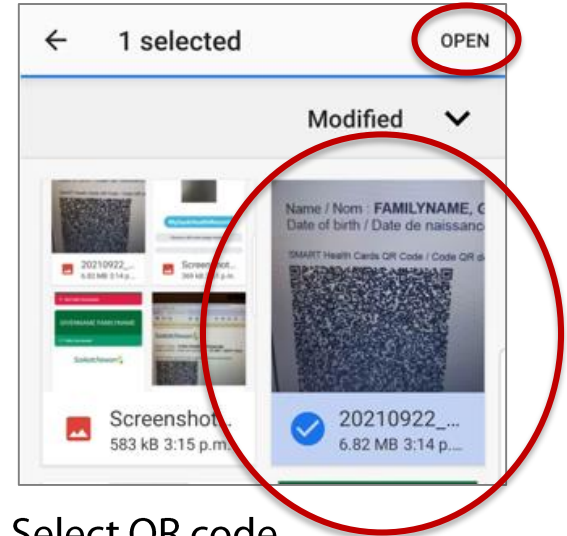


Tap “Choose a QR code image instead...”

Step 4 – Example C: Add QR code using a stored image/file

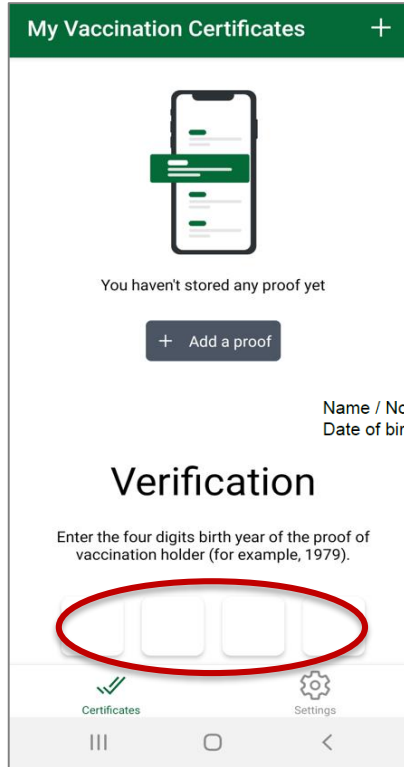


Tap on "Next" to give app permission to access files.



Select QR code image or file and tap "Open."

Step 4 – Example C: Add QR code using a stored image/file

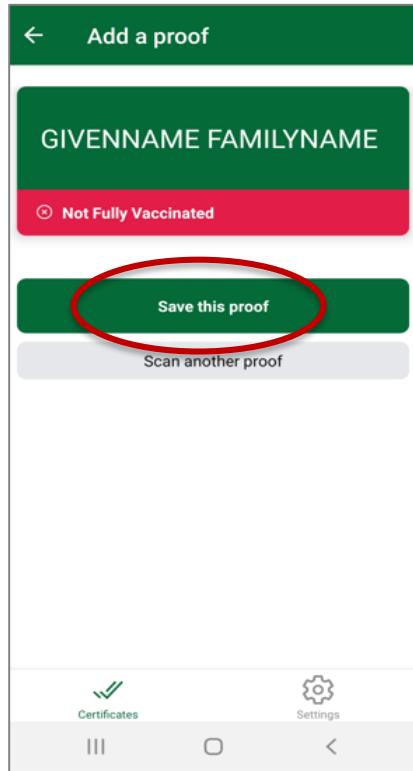

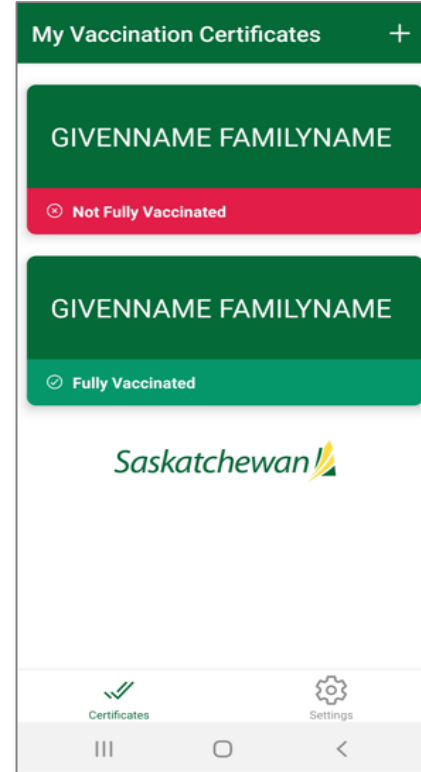
Step 5 – Save the proof of vaccination to SK Vax Wallet

Tap “Save this proof.”



Proof of vaccination is now saved in SK Vax Wallet.

You can now see the status in SK Vax Wallet.



Step 6 – Add another proof of vaccination



Tap on the “+” sign and return to Step 3.

Step 7 – Open your QR code for scanning or viewing



To show your QR code for verification at a business, organization or event:

- Open the app on your device.
- App should open to "Certificates."
- Tap on a name to open QR code/vaccination certificate.
- If your wallet contains proof of vaccination for multiple family members, tap on the one you want to view or show.

Step 8 - View or show proof of vaccination details in SK Vax wallet app

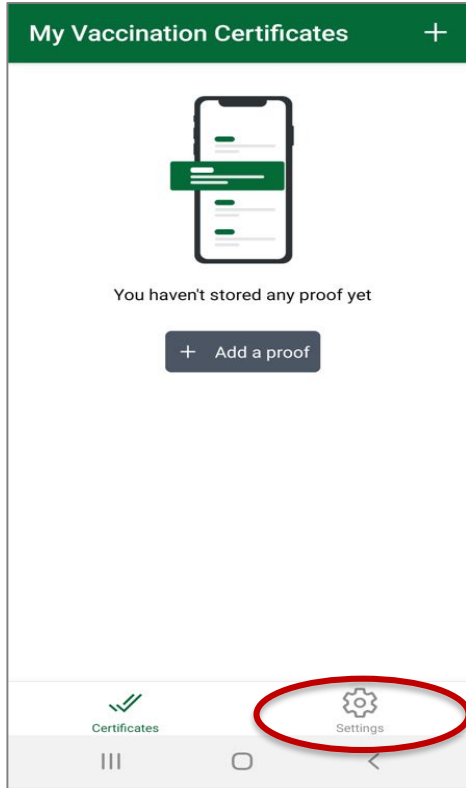


Tap on "Show details."
