ACTION REQUIRED – BILLING SOFTWARE & PAYMENT SCHEDULE CHANGES

The Physician Payment Schedule revisions outlined in this letter are **<u>effective April 1, 2021.</u>**

As outlined in the physicians' Direct Payment Agreement, payment for services submitted to Medical Services Branch is made in accordance with the applicable Physician Payment Schedule in effect on the date the service is provided. It is imperative that your billing software is utilizing the most up-to-date rate file. The new April 1, 2021, rate file has been provided to all software vendors and is posted on the Internet Claims Submission (ICS) website for download. If necessary, please contact your software vendor, to apply the update to your application and ensure your claims are being paid appropriately and/or at the new rate.

The <u>rate changes</u> are a result of the negotiated settlement between the Saskatchewan Medical Association and the Ministry of Health covering the five years from April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2022.
